Have you created your secret spy game?
Now design and make a container to keep the game in.

Equipment

1. A container, or some containers, for your spy game.
2. The materials required to play the game itself. (You should have already designed and made these.)



Safety Stuff

Becoming a secret agent can be fun, but check with an adult before you begin these projects as you might need their help. Working with items such as scissors can be dangerous, so be very careful when you use them, and make sure that you never leave them open or lying around where smaller children can reach them.

Before starting, cover the work surface with newspaper or an old cloth and make sure that you are wearing an apron or some old clothes.

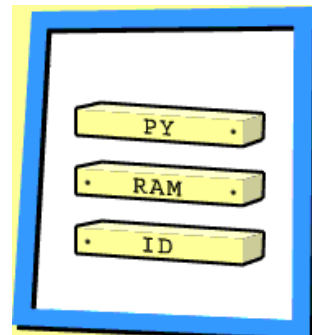
Gather together all the items you'll need before you begin. You can probably find most of what you need simply by hunting around the house, but remember to check with an adult before you take anything. After all, you don't want to be an unpopular secret agent!

Steps

Step One

First gather together the materials and objects that are required to play the game. When they are all together you can see what kind of container or containers you need.

Do you want to fit all of the parts of the game into a single container, or will there be more than one container for your game? Must any parts of the game be kept separate? Can some parts fit inside other parts to save space, for example?



Step Two

If spent matches, lollipop sticks or straws are required as part of your game, can you think of a suitable container for them?

Will your container be strong enough to protect the game? Is it easy to carry?
